

If travelling by car or minibus, you can access the Centre from **Cool Oak Lane, NW9 7ND.** Minibuses beware; there is an overhead height barrier at the entrance to Woodfield Park Playing Fields. We can open this for you if requested. You can park in the car park, or if the white barrier next to the Football club house is open, drive down the track to the Phoenix Outdoor Centre. Drivers should take extreme care on the track and in the car park and be aware that there may be children around, especially when reversing. Please do not park on the track or grass outside the Phoenix Outdoor Centre as this is public parkland and playing fields. Coaches can drop-off & collect in Cool Oak Lane, but will need to find suitable parking elsewhere. Small coaches may be able to park on site – coach companies and groups can contact us for advice in advance.
